

Eagle Men Split Games in Home Opener Weekend



METRO VANCOUVER, BC – (November 28, 2011) – The Kwantlen Polytechnic University Eagles Men’s basketball team hosted Columbia Bible College (CBC) during their season home opener on Friday, November 25th rallying to a successful wins against the Bearcats from Abbotsford.

In front of a vocal crowd of family and KPU students, the Eagle Men thrilled the masses with a closely contested match against the Bearcats. A fast-paced game, the Eagles narrowly held onto the lead for the majority of the game and only widened the gap at the end of the fourth quarter with a 94 – 82 victory. Freshman guard, Aaron Ram (Surrey), led the team with 21 points followed closely by veteran center, Ali Bosir’s (Surrey) monster game with 18 points and 18 rebounds. Recent PACWEST “Athlete of the Week”, AJ Adusei (North Delta), also added to the win with a strong showing of 17 points and 7 assists. Besides the back-to-back home team victories, the highlight for the home crowd was a huge dunk by Ali Bosir over two Bearcats opponents in the third quarter.

Speaking of the tight home game victory, head coach Stefon Wilson, stated “The fans really gave us a home court advantage. It was good to see Ali come alive recording two double-doubles.”

The Eagles’ second game of the weekend saw them visiting the Douglas College Royals on Saturday, November 26th. A close game, the Eagles attacked the rim but were unable to capitalize on their fouls with 10 missed free throws contributing to the 96 – 88 loss. Aaron Ram (Surrey) continued his weekend of terror by adding another 25 points during the game. Second-year point guard, AJ Adusei (North Delta) led the team with 26 points while third-year center, Ali Bosir (Surrey) added another weekend double-double with 10 points and 13 rebounds. After Week 3 in regular season league play, the Eagles Men’s team sits at a 2 – 4 record.

The Eagles Men’s team will play their next game before the lengthy holiday break Thursday, December 1st at Langara College with an 8PM tip off.
