Eagle Women on a Roll!



METRO VANCOUVER, BC – (December 2, 2011) – The Kwantlen Polytechnic University Eagles women’s basketball team added their third straight victory with a win over the Langara College Falcons on Thursday night. The 55 – 46 prevail currently places the Eagle Women in third place in the PACWEST standings at the beginning of Week 4 action.

Although the beginning of the game was slow for the Eagle Women, the team came back for a good second half. Criminology student and third-year guard, Anna Work (Everett, WA) continued to have a strong season and enjoyed another high scoring game, picking up 17 points and going 7 for 22. Sam McPhail (Vancouver), second-year centre, contributed another convincing showing against the Falcons collecting 12 rebounds, 2 steals, 2 blocks, and 5 points. First-year guard, Jessica Villadiego (Surrey), had a great game anchoring the Eagle team defensively and continually shows up every game with a solid presence in the paint for the team.

“Ultimately, it was an entire team effort,” stated head coach, Dan Nayebzadeh. “The ladies executed the game plan very well and controlled the tempo throughout the game. They didn’t allow Langara to slow down the pace for the entire game.”

The Eagle Women finish 4 – 3 in the PACWEST standings leading into a long break over the holiday season while looking forward to seven of the next nine games being home games when the season continues in the New Year. Next, the Eagle Women will travel north to Prince George to play the UNBC Timberwolves on January 13th, 2012.
