## **Voluntary extended health and dental plans**

Effective September 1, 2009, the College Pension Board of Trustees is offering access to new, unsubsidized group extended health and dental coverage to retired members and discontinuing post-retirement group benefit subsidies.

This bulletin contains plan details and premium rates.

### **Voluntary extended health**

Deductible	\$250/person/calendar year
Coinsurance	80 per cent first \$1,000; 100 per cent thereafter
Maximum	\$150,000 lifetime
Vision	\$150/two calendar years \$150/calendar year (child)
Orthotics	\$500/shoes, orthotics combined/calendar year
Hearing aids	\$700/four calendar years/adult \$700/two calendar years/child
Paramedicals:	\$250/person/calendar year/per paramedical, includes physiotherapist, massage, chiropractor, naturopath, podiatrist, acupuncturist, psychologist
Out of Canada	No coverage

Single	\$ 62.51/month
Couple	\$125.01/month
Family	\$243.78/month

## Voluntary dental

Essential Plan	
Deductible	\$100/calendar year
Coinsurance	Basic services only: 75 per cent
Maximum combined	\$1,000/calendar year
Recall	2/calendar year

### Rates:

Single	\$21.04
Couple	\$39.97
Family	\$56.80

## Enhanced Plan

Deductible	\$100/calendar year
Coinsurance	Basic services: 75 per cent; Major: 75 per cent
Maximum combined	\$2,000/calendar year
Recall	2/calendar year

### Rates:

Single	\$ 46.65
Couple	\$ 88.65
Family	\$125.97
