

COMMUNITY BORROWERS/VISITORS

Visitors from the community are welcome at all campuses of Kwantlen Coast Capital Savings Library. Visitors are able to use most library collections and services when in the Library, and have access to reference assistance both in the Library, by telephone or via our *Email a Librarian* and *Ask Away* services.

Anyone living within the lower mainland, 14 years of age or older can be issued a Community Borrower Card that allows the borrowing of general collection library materials. There is a charge of \$20 for four months for this card. Exceptions to the fee for a Community Borrower Card are faculty, staff and students who hold a COPPUL card or have a library card from Institutions with whom the Library has a Reciprocal Borrowing Agreement, local area high school students, and seniors (65+). Borrowing privileges for those who hold a Community Borrower Card are outlined on the Library website under the Visitors' link.

Guest computers

Each campus Library has a small number of guest computers that provide visitors with access to the Internet, the Library catalogue, research databases and programs such as Microsoft Office. Access to Library subscription research databases is available only from the Guest computers at Kwantlen libraries, not from offsite.
