Admission Requirements:

- A score of 300 or higher in the Optometry Admission Test (must be taken within 2 years of admission).
- A minimum average of 75% in all courses (average GPA's of students accepted in recent years were 82% to 94%).
- Admission is based on academic and non-academic performance. In addition to the following requisite courses, admission will also be based on an autobiographical sketch, job-shadowing/working with an optometrist, references, and interview.
